- It only costs the residents of Camden County a little over \$1.00 per day for Wastewater Treatment.


What can we all do to help conserve water.....

Access to our highly trained personnel who can answer any questions you and your students may have about the environment and wastewater treatment in Camden County.


CCMUA Environmental Laboratory
