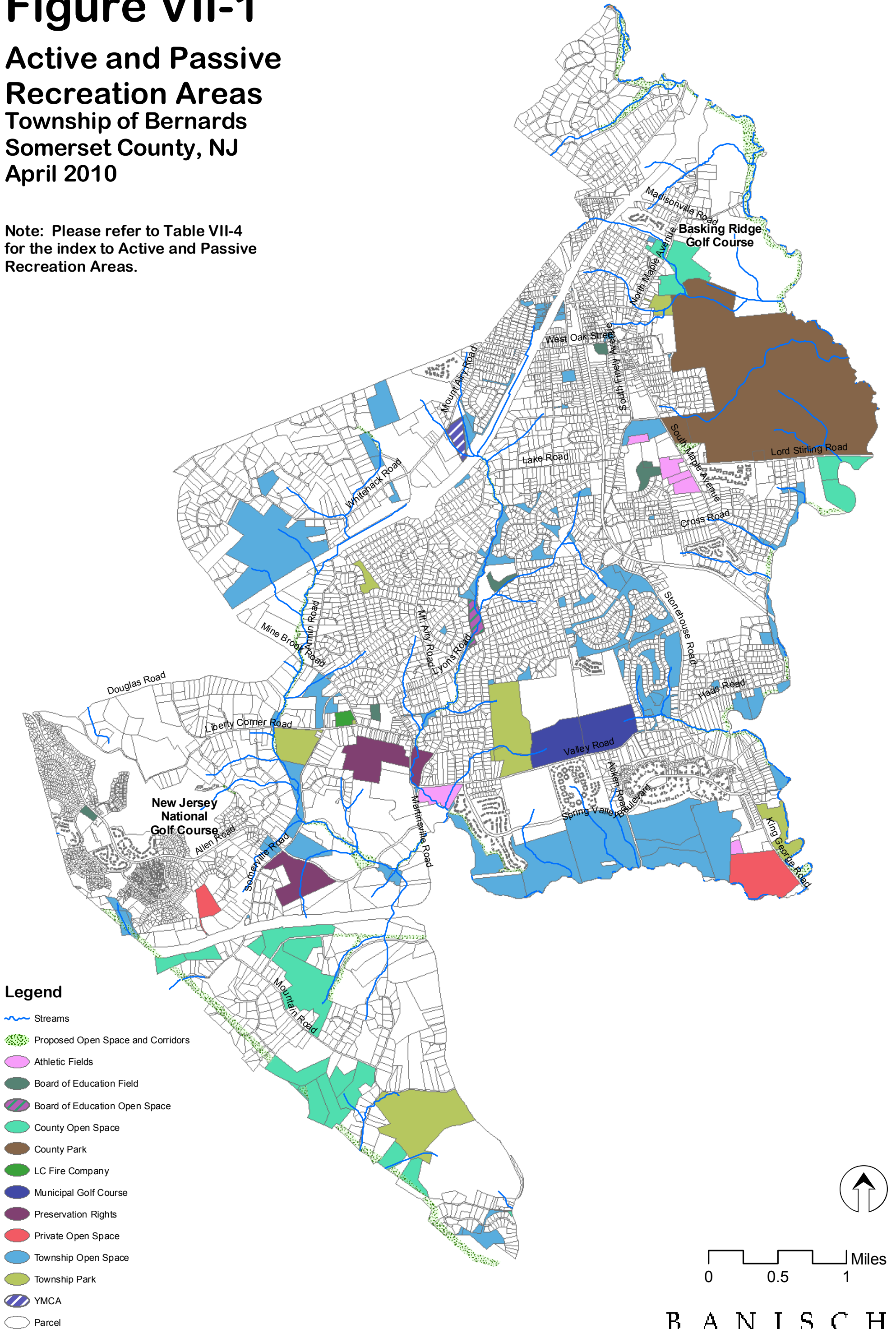

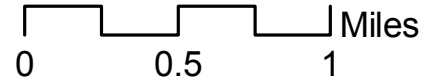
Active and Passive Recreation Areas Township of Bernards Somerset County, NJ April 2010

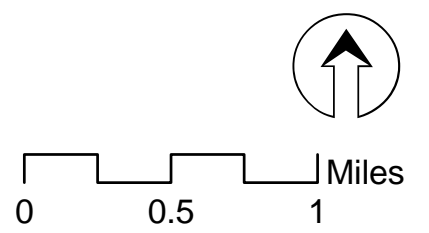

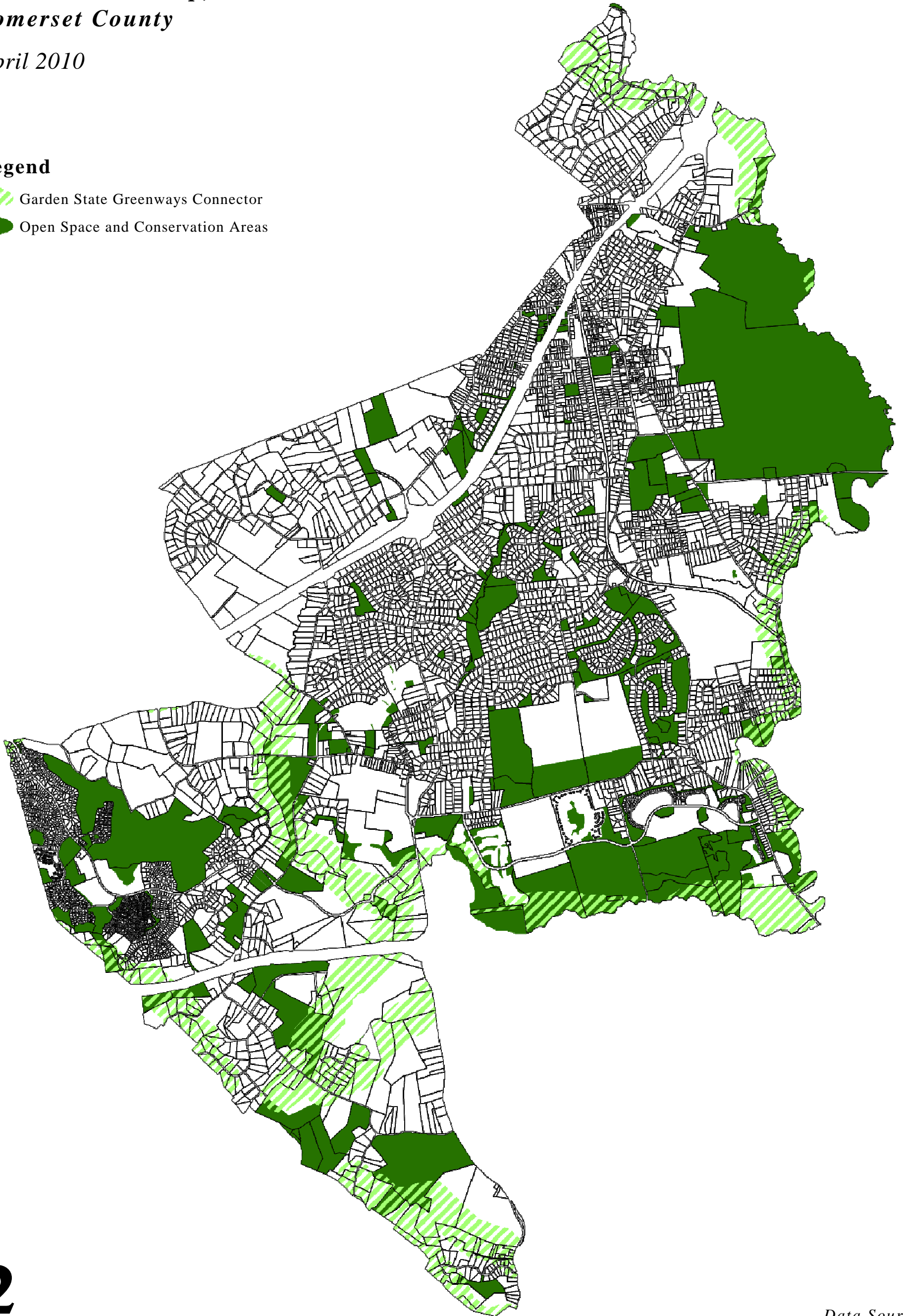

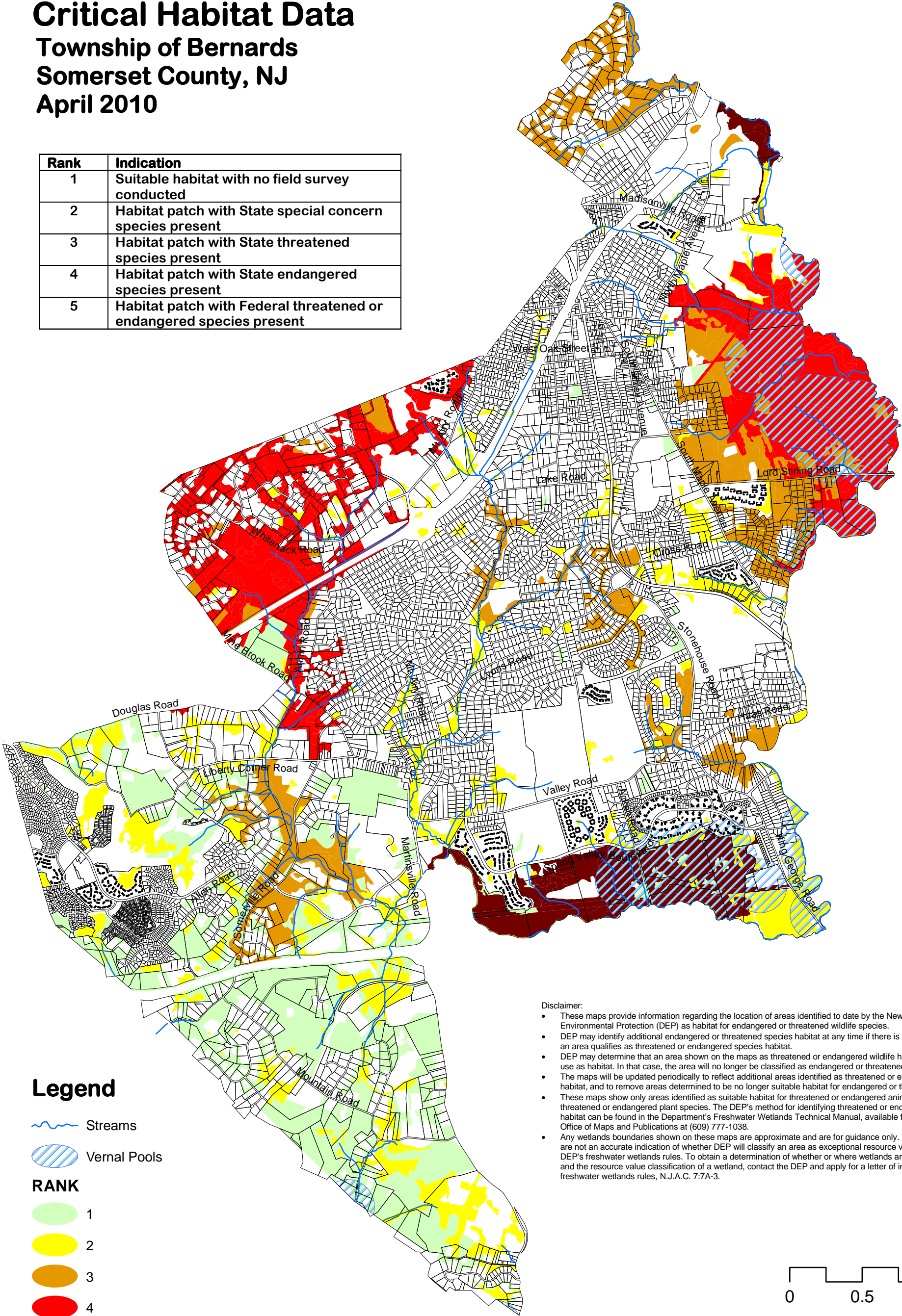
